Several of these suggested memorial gifts originated with the studies made by the Lamb Studios, the New York firm commissioned by the vestry in 1991 to make suggestions for the improvements to the church, and are intended to conform to a long-range plan.

A reminder—funds may be designated for a specific memorial or may be undesignated and added to the Memorial Fund for use toward suitable memorials as selected by the committee. Suggested memorials not on the list are welcome but must be approved by the committee and the Vestry before they are accepted. About the Pipe Organ

The Pipe Organ Fund was established several years ago to receive gifts towards the possibility of a new instrument for our worship space. As part of the church renovation project in 2005, a Johannus electronic organ was purchased and installed. Real pipes can be added to and played by this instrument. The clergy and Memorials Committee would be glad to discuss major gifts to fund either new ranks of pipes or an entirely new pipe organ system, recognizing that final approval must come from the Vestry. Meanwhile, the Pipe Organ Fund is managed by a professional investment advisor, under the auspices of the St. Philip's Foundation in order to maximize the potential value of all gifts.
